Enhance and Update K-12 Curriculum and Materials



- Complete by the end of 2020-2021 school year.
- Prioritize the areas of greatest need to determine order of completion.

 \triangleright Complete by the end of 2020-2021.

- * Purchase new books and materials to update the K-12 curriculum.
 - Acquire books and materials for one subject area per year.
 - Buy on a yearly cycle finishing the project in the year 2025.
- * Increase electives and additional offerings for all grade levels.
 - Add new electives for elementary, middle, and high school.
 - Complete by end of 2020-2021 school year.
 - Research programs such as 4H and FFA to determine feasible additions.
 - Complete by 2021-2022 school year







- * Create a Professional Development Program for Faculty.
 - Provide opportunities for continuous learning throughout the school year.
 - Build-in two professional development days into the 2021-2022 school calendar, not including pre-planning and post-planning. One day will be fixed (GISA Conference); one day will be as needed by individual faculty members.
 - Create professional learning communities in each subject area.
 - > Meet three times per year to collaborate and train.
 - > Establish a mentor program for new faculty members.
 - ▶ Have finalized and functional by the 2021-2022 school year.
- * Create a Positive Student Experience.
 - 1-Plan on-campus and off-campus, social and spiritual events, to promote unity and growth.
 - Establish a milestone event or class tradition for all grades 6-12.
 - ➤ Complete by the end of 2020-2021 school year.
 - 2- Promote a Culture of Student Pride and Ownership Through Encouragement of Increased Student Input.
 - Re-establish the Middle School Student Government Association for the 2021-2022 school year.
 - Establish an Elementary School Student Government Association by 2022-2023 school year.
 - Invite the SGA officers to attend scheduled Board Meetings two times every school year to provide a student body update. Visits will begin in the spring of 2021.
 - Monthly interactions between administrators and SGA to begin spring 2021.

Enhance and Update School Facilities



- * Upgrade Athletic Facilities to improve the overall curb appeal and functionality.
 - Complete the proposed Booster Club Project dealing with the beautification of the Baseball, Football, and Softball Facilities.
 - Build a multi-purpose facility to provide year-round locker room space and training areas for athletic teams.
 - Funded by a Capital Campaign and completed by Fall 2025.
 - 3-Use donated materials to build additional storage space for teams and clubs.
 - Complete by Spring 2023.
- * Make upgrades and additions to the school's main plant.
 - Repurpose current space to create a STEM Lab and Maker Space for the Elementary, Middle, and High School.
 - Complete by the end of the 2021-2022 school year.
 - Make needed repairs to the Lunchroom and Elementary School roofs.
 - Extend the current High School Building to add classrooms and replace the modular buildings.
 - Funded by a Capital Campaign and completed by Fall 2025.
 - > Update the front of the Elementary School facade.
 - Funded by Annual Fund and independent donors and completed by Spring 2024.

* Renovation of Existing Facilities.

- Paint the interior and exterior of the gym and upgrade the signage.
- Beautify and secure the Elementary School Playground.
 - Complete by the end of the 2021-2022 school year.
- Modify and reinstall the stairs to the girls' locker room in the gym.
 - Complete by the end of the 2021-2022 school year
